

To provide you with a quotation for a Carnet, we will require the following key information points:

- 1 Total value of the goods in GBP
- 2 How long the Carnet is required for (2, 6 or 12 months)
- 3 Countries that the goods under the Carnet will be visiting
- 4 A general description of the goods

ESSENTIAL CARNET DETAILS

The principles of the ATA Carnet system are ownership (responsibility) and that the goods which arrive are exactly as those you left with. Established by:

- 1 The Carnet holder (normally the owner of the goods) responsible for potential duties to foreign customs
- 2 Details of the individuals or agents who will travel with the goods and oversee customs transit
- 3 Intended use of the goods (to establish appropriate Carnet categories)
- 4 A clear list of goods to be taken, individually itemised and with identifying information i.e. brand names and serial numbers
- 5 Quantity, value, country of origin of each item
- 6 Total weight
